These two beach towels show their albedo patterns: one representing the full reflection of a ray of light on a white surface (albedo=1), the other representing its absorption by a dark surface (albedo=0). While the white ice floes of the North and South Poles mostly reflect sunlight, they absorb the sun's heat via the sea that surrounds them. As icecaps diminish, the polar seas become darker, which in turn accelerates the absorption of visual heat.

With these towels in your wardrobe, you can witness this process from your spot at the beach, as you take a well-deserved moment to reflect—or absorb.

USER GUIDE:

"Take these towels with you to the beach with a person of your choice. Lie back on the towel to get a tan. Whilst you feel the sun's heat on your skin, think about the patterns on which you are lying and the melting of ice floes. Be careful, however: it might cause you to make unexpected decisions concerning notably air travel, eating meat, and insulating your home."
